His idea was: "If you want to be rich, you need to learn how to be a business owner and/ or investor". That's what inspired me to pursue my business. The year I graduated from City University, I formed Boogles Ltd. I had business advisors who met with me once in a while and helped me focus on my next steps. I started the business from home before expanding; now we have offices in Nottingham and London.
